CBP brokers and ocean freight forwarders commonly select and instruct motor carriers to haul cargo. Delivery orders beyond the commercial zone are subject to Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration regulations. Like freight brokers, CBP brokers are required to exercise reasonable care when selecting a motor carrier and could be held responsible as an “employer” if the motor carrier kills a motorist or loses the cargo.
